Local Fire and Rescue Service Plan Priorities

The Local Fire and Rescue Service Plan has been developed to set out the priorities and objectives within East Dunbartonshire and allows our local authority partners to scrutinise the performance outcomes of these priorities.

We will continue to work closely with our partners in East Dunbartonshire to ensure that through targetting risks at a local level we are all **"Working Together for a Safer Scotland."**

The plan has been developed to complement key partnership activity embedded across East Dunbartonshires Community Plan and associated Delivery and Thematic plans. Through partnership working we will seek to deliver continuous improvement in our performance and effective service delivery in our area of operations.

The Local Fire and Rescue Plan for East Dunbartonshire identified six areas for demand reduction and is subject to regular monitoring and reporting through the Police & Fire and Rescue Committee. A summary of the priorities and current activity is detailed below with further detail and analysis contained within this performance report.

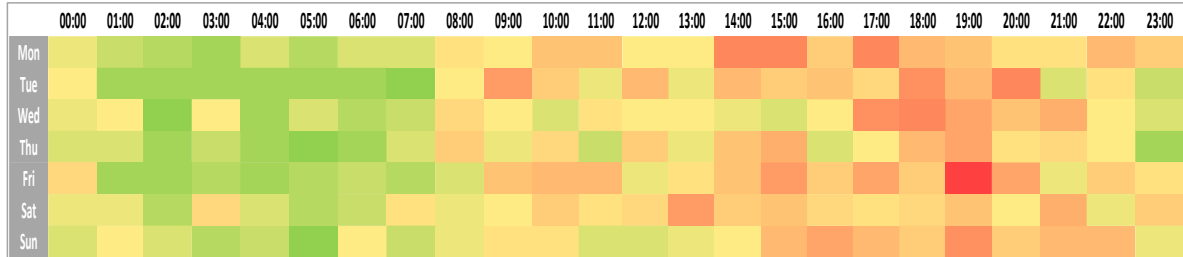

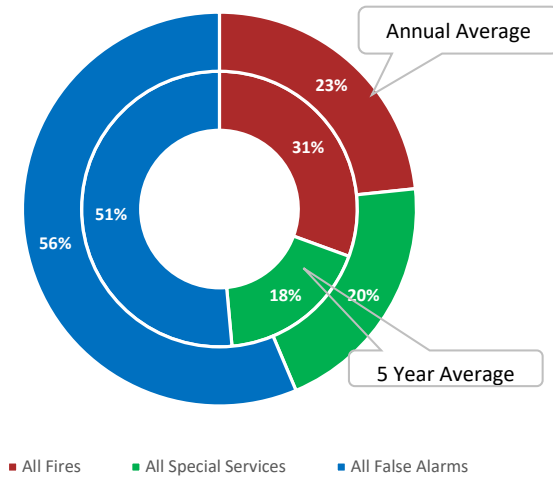

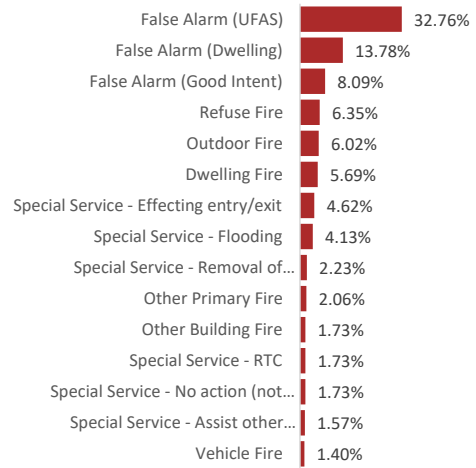
Activity by Time of Day



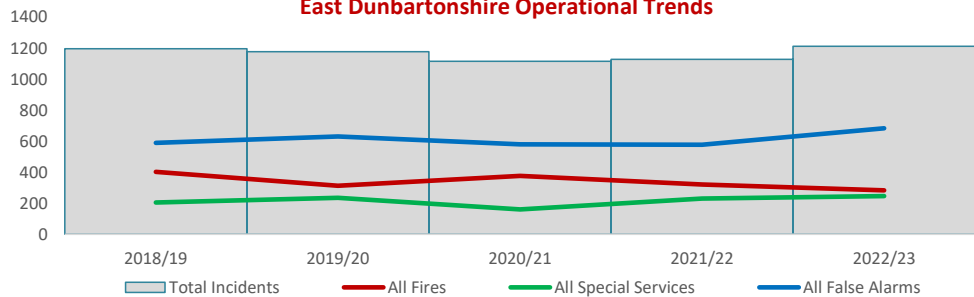
Incidents by Classification

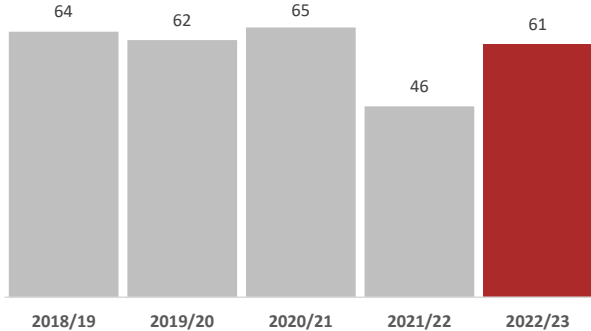

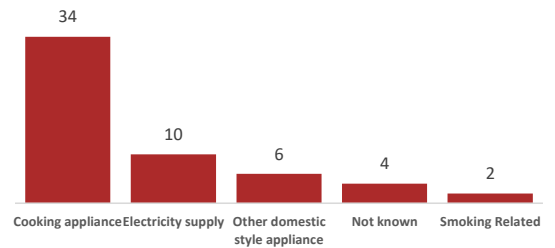

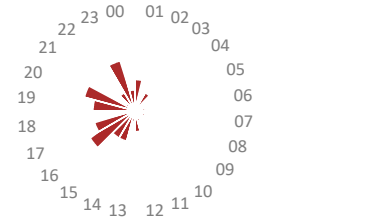

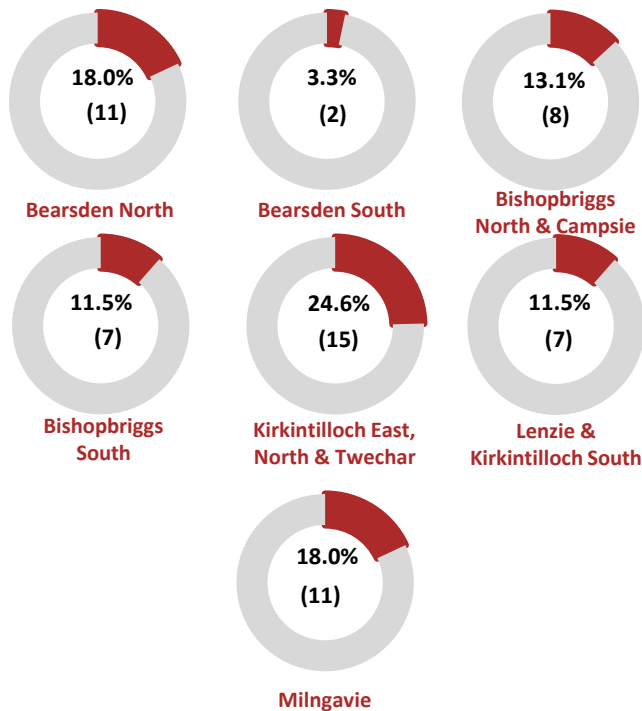
Main Source of Ignition

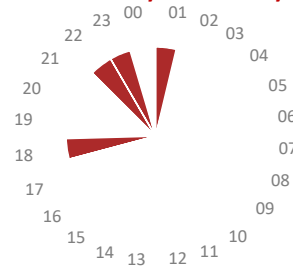

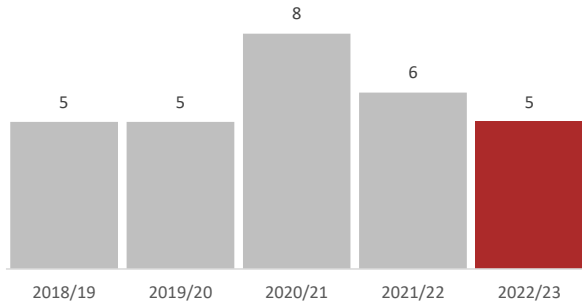

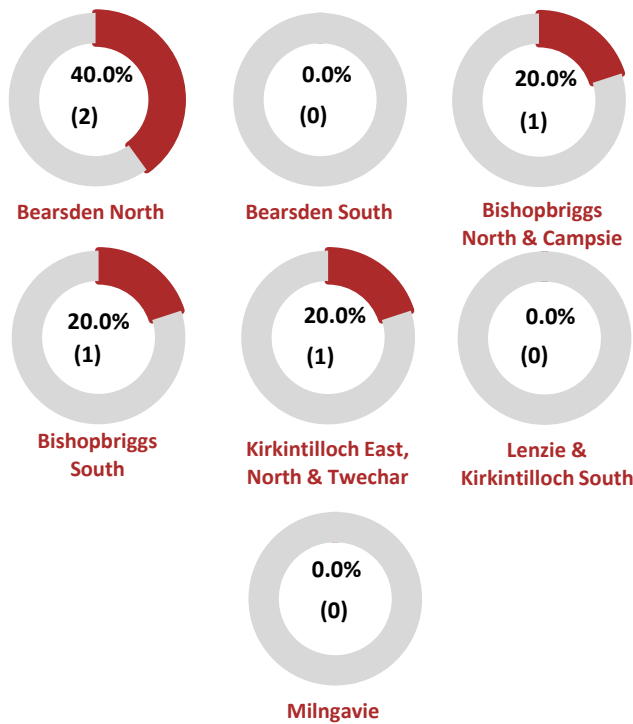
Fire Casualties by Time of Day



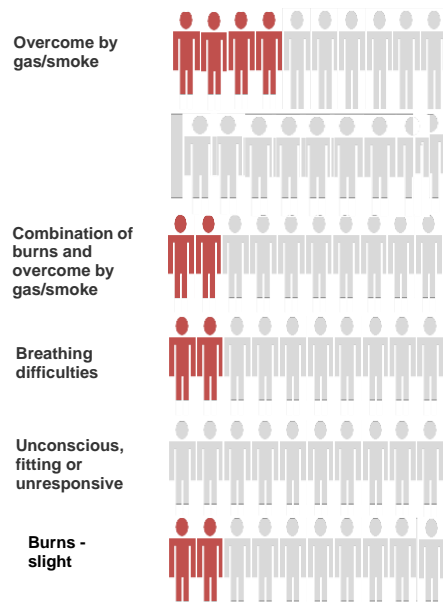
Accidental Dwelling Fire Casualties Year to Date



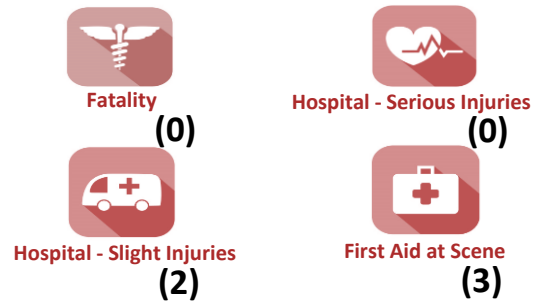
Accidental Dwelling Fire Casualties by Ward (% share)



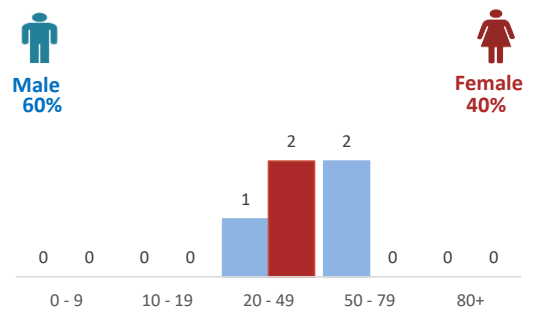

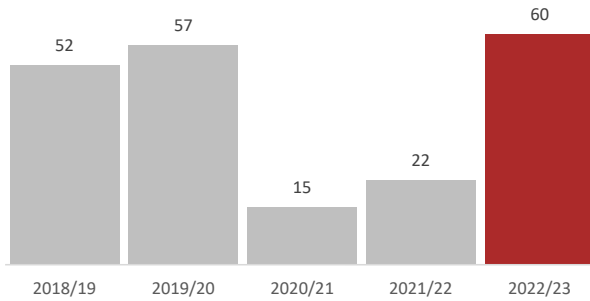

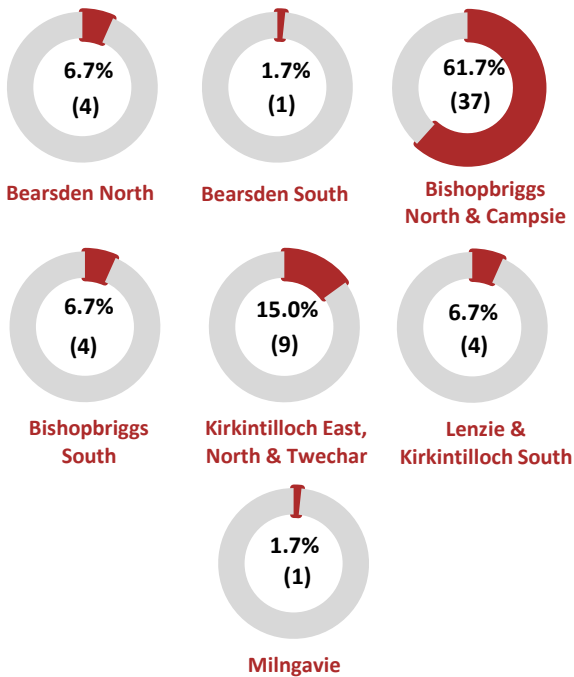

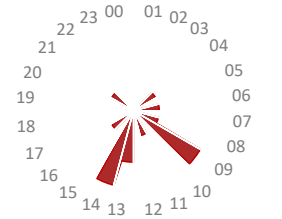

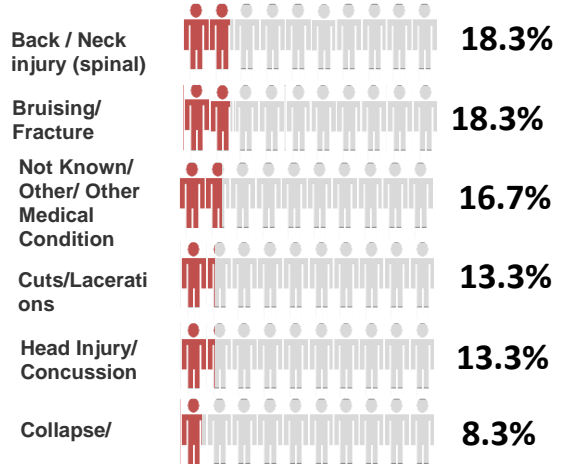
Non-Fire Casualties by Ward (% share)



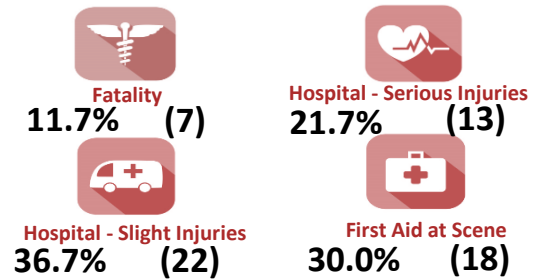

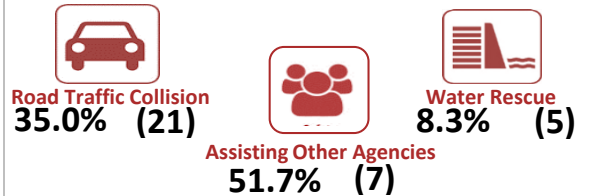

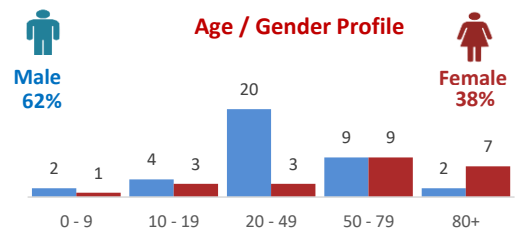

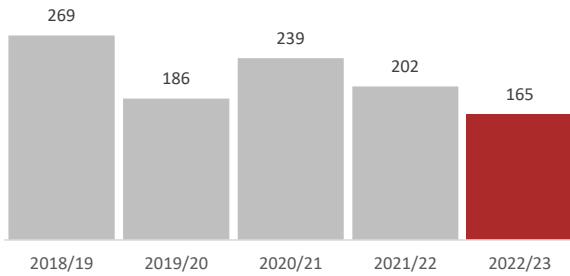

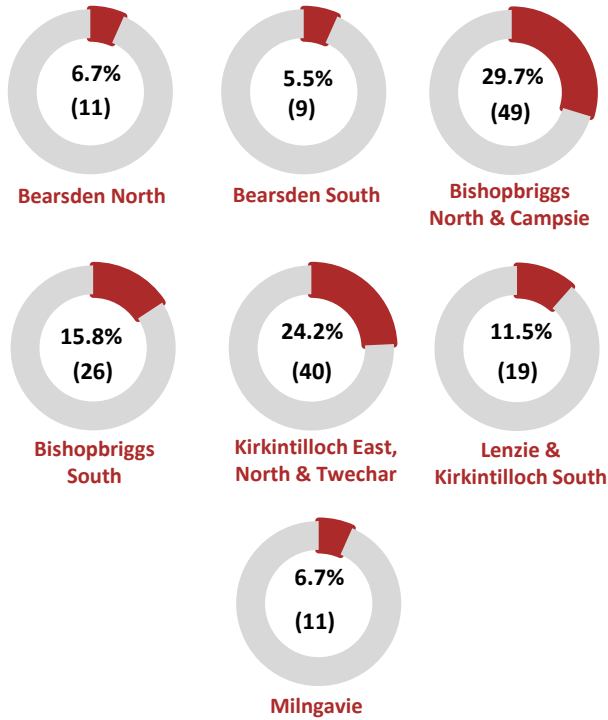

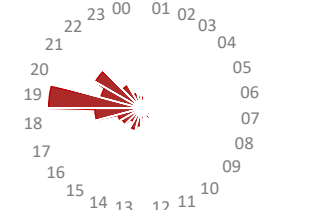

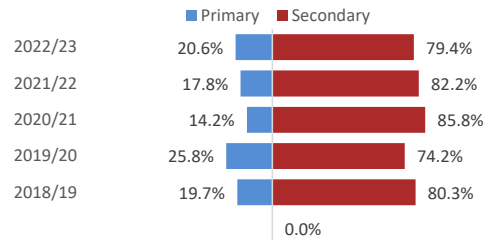
Deliberate Fires by Ward (% share)



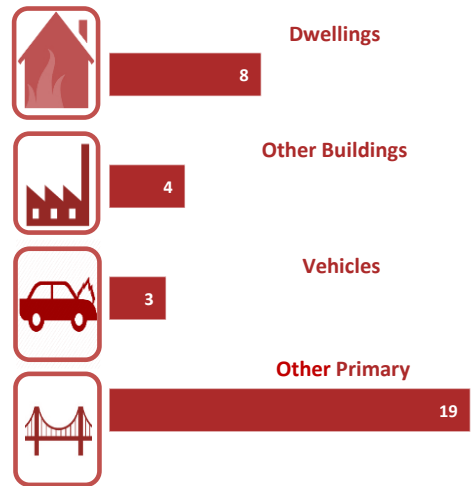
Deliberate Fires by Time of Day



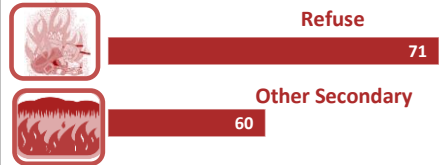

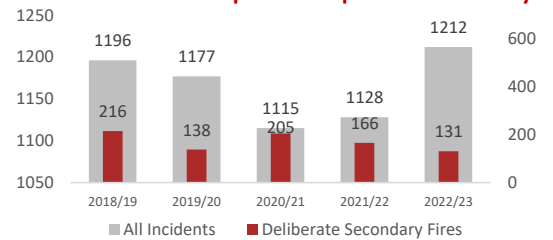
Primary Fire Ratio by Activity Type

Deliberate Fires Compared to Operational Activity



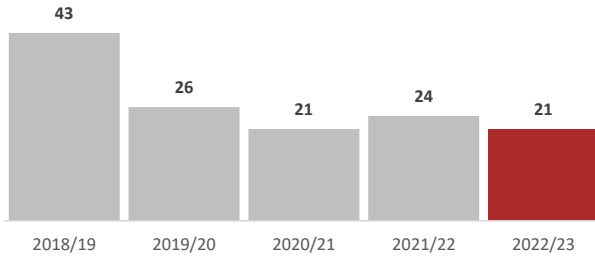

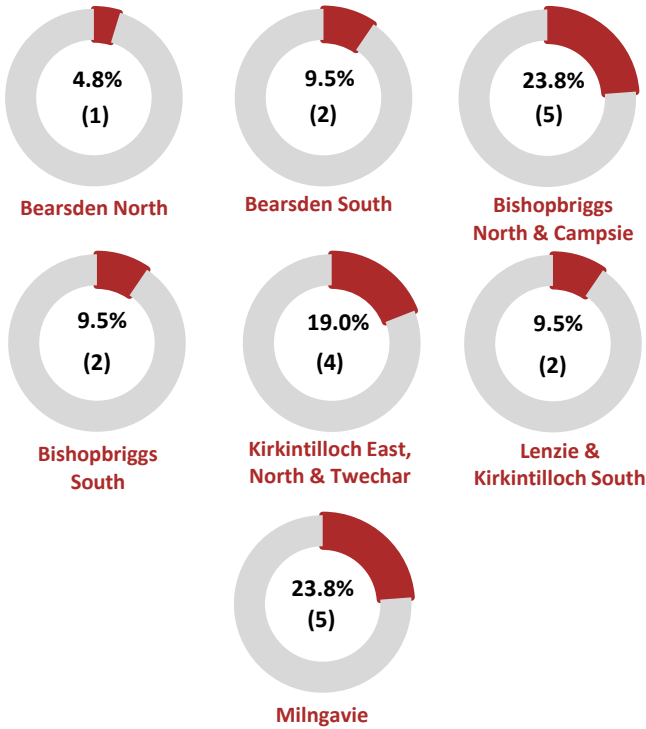

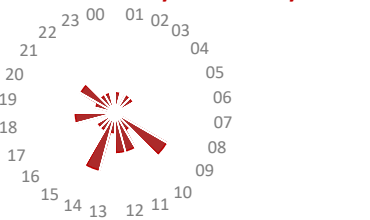

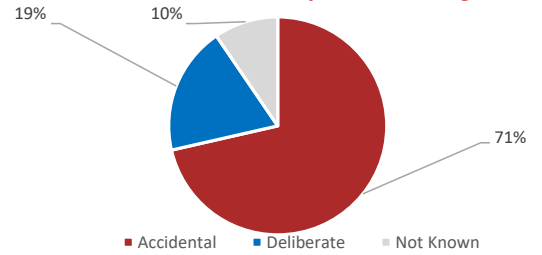
Non-Domestic Fires by Ward (% share)

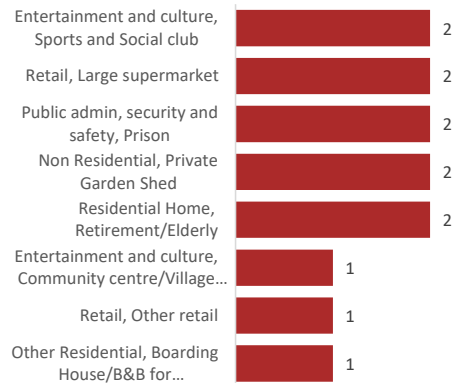

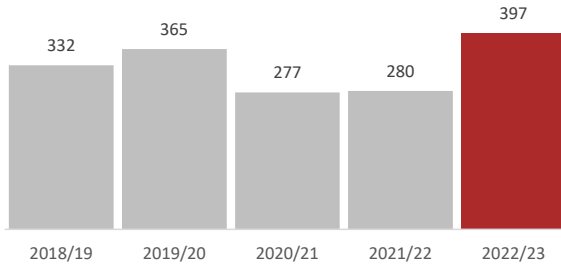

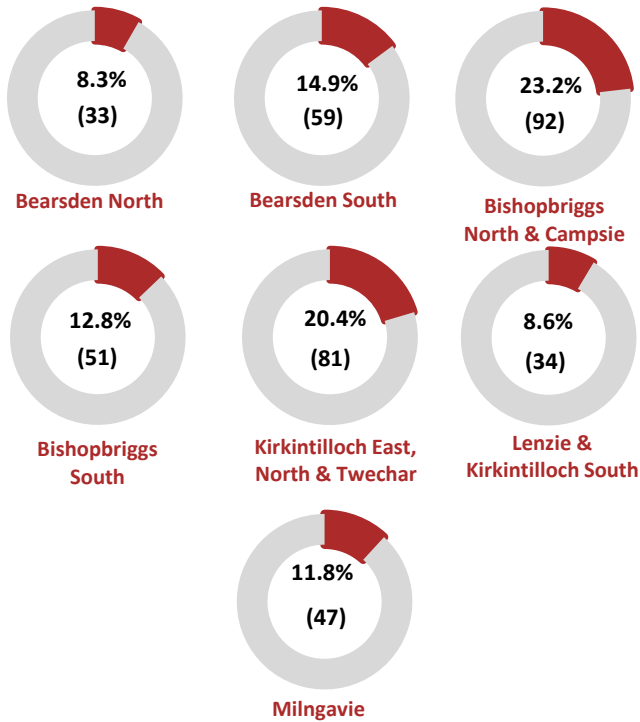

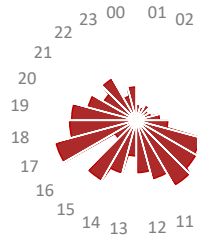

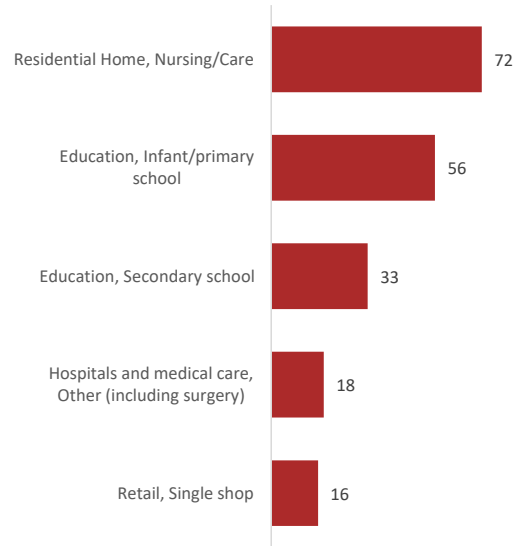
Unwanted Fire Alarm Signals by Ward (% share)



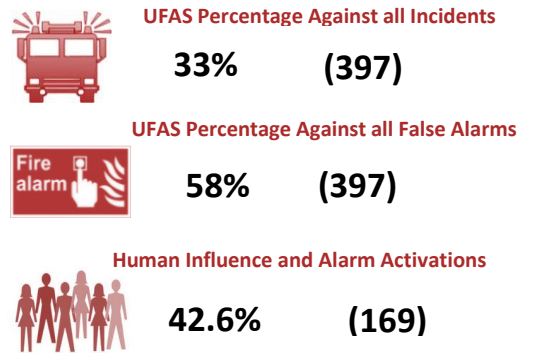
Unwanted Fire Alarm Signals by Time of Day
